


This is a user manual for the community volunteers/ facilitators. It also serves as training module for the master trainers and the volunteer/community facilitator.

This manual in the shape of a flip book on integrated farming is meant to be a reference document for lead farmers who implement some of the Integrated Farming Systems in their own farms.


A compilation of the good practices adopted by Welthungerhilfe's partner NGOs working in food and nutrition security in Bangladesh, India and Nepal.
